YGK Healthcare Champions 2026: Funding Request Application



The YGK Healthcare Champions (YGKHC) provide funding to support priority items for Kingston Health Sciences Centre (KHSC) and Providence Care. The successful applicant(s) will receive funding through University Hospitals Kingston Foundation (UHKF).

Examples could include the following:

- Funding for medical equipment, programs or research which increase the scope of patient care.
- Funding for medical equipment, programs or research which increase engagement with patients.

Eligibility

The award will be available exclusively to paid employees or affiliated physicians of Kingston Health Sciences Centre (KHSC) and Providence Care. Applications can be made by individuals, departments or a team.

Key Questions to Be Considered in Evaluating Applications

- Is the implementation of this feasible and can it be completed this fiscal year?
- The YGKHC grant must fully fund your request; your project cannot require additional grants from other funds.
- If your project does not require the full amount of allocated funding, the department **must** utilize any remaining funds for other purposes.

Criteria for Selection of Recipients

Applicants must submit their application in writing, adhering to the process outlined below. All required information must fit within the form's designated sections, no additional supporting materials will be accepted.

- The written application must include a description of the proposed project, research or equipment.
- The medical equipment, program or research must be in an area that is expected to have a direct beneficial impact on patient care at KHSC or Providence Care.
- A letter from the applicant's operational director, agreeing to proceed with the project if funding is awarded, must accompany the submission.

Award Value

- **Up to \$50,000** will be granted.
- If there are additional funds raised over \$50,000, they will be directed to support the winning applicant's department.

Review Schedule and Deadlines

All applications will undergo a review panel process by the YGK Healthcare Champions committee.

- June 16: Applications go live and are shared with staff and affiliated physicians.
- September 8: Deadline for application submissions.
- September 30: The final three candidates will be notified.
- October 21: The final three candidates will be selected to present their projects to the YGK Healthcare Champion members (in-person or via Microsoft Teams).
- October 22: Winner announced.
- November 2025 August 2025: YGKHC will start fundraising for the winning project.
- September 2026: Funds will be granted.

Instructions

- The application must be written in such a way as to allow assessment by individuals, not experts in their field and must clearly define the nature of your proposal.
- Keep each answer to no more than approximately 1600 characters (not words).
- Application submissions must include the full name(s) of the individual(s) submitting the application, work email address(es) and department name.
- Submission instructions are outlined at the end of the application form.

Note: If the above instructions are not followed, applications will be disqualified.
